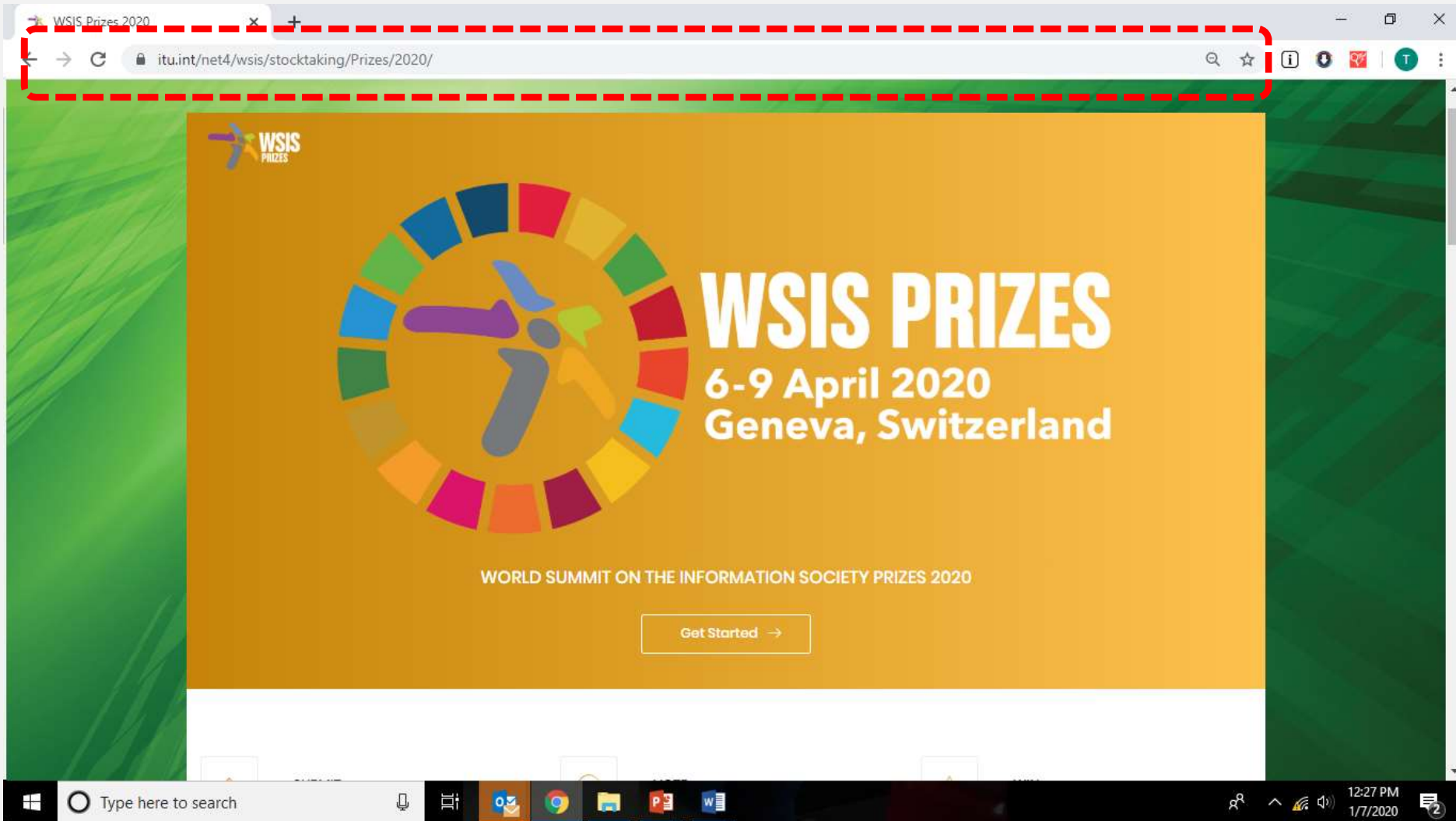
GUIDELINE TO VOTE PANDUAN UNTUK MENGUNDI

- **You must register before you can vote**

- **You must vote in ALL 18 categories**

- **You can only vote one project in each category**

- **Your vote will only be counted once you have voted in all 18 categories**

- **No age limit to vote. Anyone that has registered can vote**
